LANGUAGES DEPARTMENT

On March 14, 2026, five VSS students will be flying off to Frankfurt, Germany to begin their 10-week exchange to various cities, towns and villages in the German state of Rhineland-Palatinate. In the fall of 2025, these students hosted a German partner in their house for the same period. The German students arrived in late August and returned at the beginning of November and now almost 6 months later, the VSS students, as well as ten other students throughout the province, get to experience daily life and school in Germany. While attending school, the students will improve their German, learn about German culture and make memories for a lifetime.

This province wide exchange program has been in existence for over 40 years and runs in partnership with the Ministry of Education in Mainz, Germany. You do not need to be taking German at school to participate; you just need to be in good standing with the school, going into grade 10, 11 or 12 next school year and passing all your classes. However, taking German would be an asset.
